## The Summer Enrichment Education Program

Mayor Kasim Reed wants to give APS high school juniors and seniors a jumpstart towards college and their careers! Under the Mayor's Summer Enrichment Education Program (SEEP), students can take the initiative by training early.

SEEP is the Mayor's joint effort between Atlanta Workforce Development Agency (AWDA), Atlanta Public Schools, and Atlanta Technical College to offer career-focused summer programs that will help our youth enter the workforce qualified and prepared to work. Under SEEP, students from the Atlanta Public School System can earn college credits in high-demand careers during the summer break. Eligible students take courses at Atlanta Technical College such as Patient Care Assisting, Shampoo Technician, Small Business Marketing Manager and many more! Classes are taught by an ATC instructor on the ATC campus, and they will receive a letter grade from the college.

Students must meet college entrance requirements in order to participate. These classes will not affect your HOPE cap!

## How Do You Participate in the SEEP Program?

### STEPS TO TAKE...

- MEET WITH AN ATLANTA WORKFORCE MAYOR'S YOUTH PROGRAM (MYP) COUNSELOR TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SUMMER PROGRAM OF YOUR CHOICE.
- BRING THE FOLLOING REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO YOUR MYP COUNSELOR:

1. GEORGIA STATE ID OR GA DRIVER'S LICENSE
2. SOCIAL SECURITY CARD
3. BIRTH CERTIFICATE
4. CURRENT UTILITY BILL (GAS, ELECTRIC, OR WATER)

### AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

5. FOOD STAMP LETTER (RECENT 6 MONTHS)
  6. TANF LETTER (RECENT 6 MONTHS)
  7. SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY LETTER (RECENT 6 MONTHS)
  8. PROOF OF FOSTER CARE
- MAKE THE REQUIRED TEST SCORES FOR YOUR PROGRAM OF INTEREST ON ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: ASSET, COMPASS, ACT OR SAT
  - COMPLETE ATC'S APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION AND FINANCIAL AID WITH YOUR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR
